2	Aims of the module and acquired skills <p>The module consists of a portfolio of language courses (not all of which are offered every semester) that offer skills which enable students to access, use or present materials they could not otherwise employ to advance their work. The module enables them, in particular, to specialize in a certain topic and / or work at the borders of Slavonic Studies and an adherent discipline.</p>				
3	Contents of the module <p>The module offers a choice between specialized Polish / Russian / German courses (e.g. economic or media lexis in Russian/Polish), Yiddish classes or scholarly presentations in English (at HSE). Further option depend on availability and vary from university to university.</p>				
4	Teaching/Learning methods <p>Language course</p>				
5	Requirements for participation <p>As specified in the course description; students normally need to have a good working knowledge of the language on which the course is based (only Yiddish is offered for beginners).</p>				
6	Type of module examinations <p>Presentation and written exam (90 minutes)</p>				
7	Requisites for the allocation of credits <p>Regular and active attendance (including unmarked tests and homework), passed written exam</p>				
8	Compatibility with other Curricula <p>The courses are attended by students of other Master degrees.</p>
